- Declare a Content Area of Emphasis\* no later than the start of their Junior year (Bible, ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies)
- Must complete one additional credit, beyond the minimum, within the declared Content Area of Emphasis
- Must successfully complete a minimum of 3 dual credit hours in an approved college course (may substitute for the additional credit in the student's area of emphasis)
- Must attain a minimum cumulative composite score of 20 on the ACT
- Must attain a cumulative GPA of 3.0

#### **Directed Electives Offered at Indiana Academy**

- Fine Arts Classes: Choralanas (Choir), Keynotes (Select Choir), Gracenotes (Select Bell Choir), Band, Photography
- Practical Arts Classes: Intro. to Technology, Essentials of Living, and Personal Finance
